Episode 1: Happy Spring "Canned Bunnies"

Using recycled cans and simple office supplies, create a crew of canned bunnies and other creatures.

Step 1: Gather Supplies



- plain white 8.5" x 11" printer paper
- scissors
- tape
- ruler
- empty aluminum cans
- markers, crayons or colored pencils

Step 2: Measure & Cut

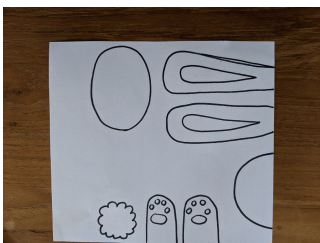


Measure $4 \frac{3}{4}$ inch up from the short end of a sheet of paper and draw a line using the ruler.

This will make a rectangle measuring $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $4 \frac{3}{4}$ ".

Cut the rectangle with scissors.

Step 3: Draw Body Parts



On the extra paper left over from your 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ inch high rectangle, draw your creature's body parts: legs, arms, tails, ears, head, horns, and belly.

Color in and decorate your creature's body parts, then cut them out.

Step 4: Cut & Tape



Tape the head and belly onto the rectangle, then draw on a mouth, whiskers, and attach the belly with tape.

Wrap the rectangle around the can and tape the seam at the back. Finally, use tape to attach other body parts, like ears, tails, legs, feet, or horns!
